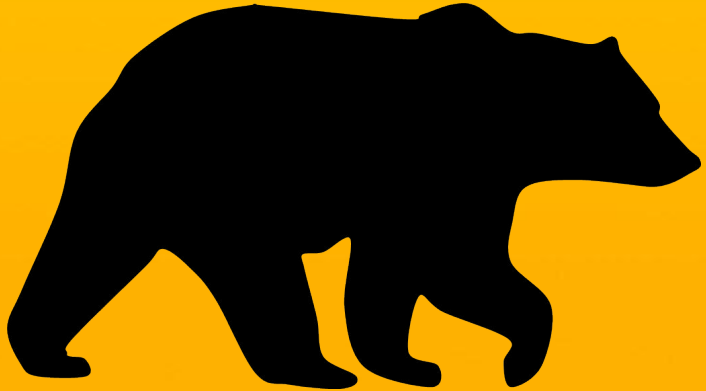

Student Orientation Information

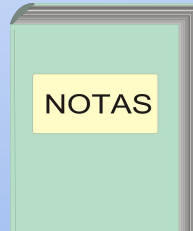
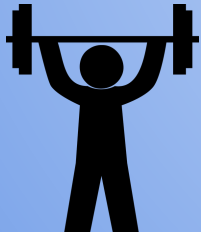
This is our school newspaper's orientation issue for your arrival at Delran Middle School. It contains valuable information for you, so read it carefully and put it to good use. Here's what's inside.

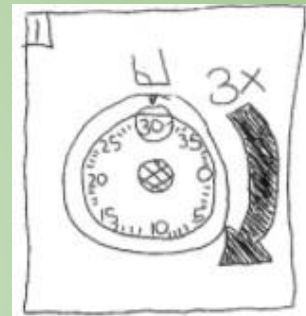




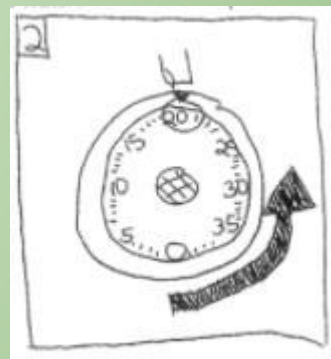
How to Open Your Locker



Turn locker dial **RIGHT** and **pass zero THREE times** and then stop at the first number in your combination.



Turn locker dial **LEFT** and **one whole turn past the first number.** Stop at the second number.

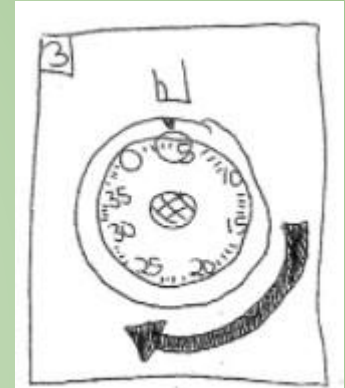




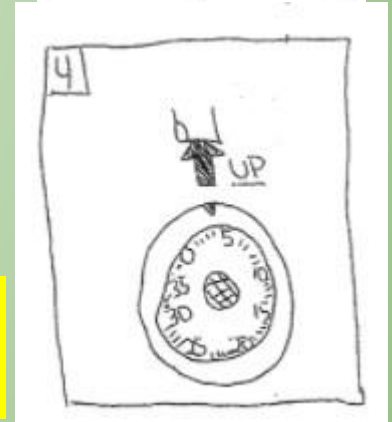
How to Open Your Locker



Turn locker dial **RIGHT** and **go directly** to the third number in your combination and **STOP**.



Push the trigger **UP** and **PULL** the locker open towards you.



HINTS: Turn your dial several times after closing your locker and **DON'T** give anyone your combination!
